1 | OBJECTIVES

The main aim of this International Workshop on Landscape will raise an appropriate balance between theoretical and practical reflection of the project as “intermediate scale”, recovering the necessary dialogue between the scales of architecture and planning of our cities and territories. This combination of esthetical and practical values, try to discover the elements of the existing architectural and urban culture through the action of the intervention of the project.

2 | STRUCTURE

- The Workshop is raised by method of an “open thinking space”, where the theory and design layouts of the proposal to develop will be discussed continuously and collectively. We will work in the main building of the School of Architecture in Malaga (Plaza El Ejido, s/n. Campus El Ejido. 29007 Málaga, Spain).

- It is organized through working groups of 8-10 students supervised by two professors of different Schools of Architecture, developing and specifying the proposal during a week of “professional work in team” with continuous schedule (9'30h. to 17'30h.) where it will be included lectures, group discussions and corrections of the exercises.

- Technical materials (planimetry, photos, information, goals...) will be delivered one month in advance so that the enrolled students are able to learn and study the content of the proposal.

- The Workshop has the entire work infrastructure needed (collective boards team, printers, reproduction material, screening room and conference facilities, Internet...). Each student must provide only his/her own personal laptop.

3 | PROPOSAL

- It is proposed a concrete intermediate scale plan on the waterfront of the Dock “Muelle Heredia” in the City Centre of Malaga, as a transition section Port-City that is required to order urbanistically and to define architecturally to be integrated into the city.

- This is an important piece of urban centrality and strategic value in that relationship City-Port of Málaga. The first day of the Workshop there will be a group visit to the site to understand and analyze its urban conditions, to take own pictures of the place, to feel the real situation and be able to work about all the problems of this urban barrier.

4 | CONDITIONS

The workshop is aimed mainly at students in their last years of career or Master's or PhD. As the limited number of places, there will be a registration by e-mail

- **The official language will be ENGLISH for all the assistants** (that will be complemented with Spanish and French).
